## MAIN PURPOSE OF THE JOB

Provides medical care to patients with Obstetric and Gynecological issues and Trains and Mentors staff.

## KEY ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Plan and coordinate CPD in his/her specialization for Health Workers at the Hospital.
2. Plan, coordinate and conduct operational research in his/her area of specialization.
3. Provide technical and professional advice in his/her area of specialization to the Hospital.
4. Provides medical care to patients in the Department
5. Monitors and treats expectant mothers during pregnancy, childbirth, and postpartum.
6. Deal with a wide range of issues, including obstetrics, or pregnancy and childbirth, menstruation and fertility issues, sexually transmitted infections (STIs), hormone disorders, and others.
7. Trains and mentors intern Doctors
8. Performing annual and regular examinations on patients to diagnose various gynecological conditions.
9. Recording and updating patients' medical histories.
10. Advise patients on suitable birth control options.
11. Performs various diagnostic tests on patients, which include Pap smears, STD tests, ultrasounds, hormone profile blood tests, colposcopies, and endometrial biopsies.
12. Explains test results, diagnoses, and treatment options to patients.
13. Performs surgeries and gynecological procedures on patients, such as cervical cryosurgeries, dilation and curettages, pelvic laparoscopies, and sterilizations.
14. Refer patients to other healthcare specialists as needed.
15. Educating patients on reproductive health issues and disease prevention.
